The Bomber Command Museum Is Now On Our Winter Schedule


The museum is only open on weekends from 10:00 until 4:00 April 16th.

October 18-20

- Our museum's portable half-scale "Canada's Bomber Command Memorial Wall" will be on display in Saskatoon at the Annual Conference of the Royal Canadian Air Force Association. Museum Directors Dan Fox and Karl Kjarsgaard have been invited to make a presentation regarding our proposed expansion plans at the AGM.



November 2-11

- Our museum's portable half-scale "Canada's Bomber Command Memorial Wall will be on display in Ottawa at the Canada Air and Space Museum. "The Belgian Forest," the museum's tribute video regarding our contribution to the Bomber Command Memorial in London, will be shown in the museum's theatre.

November 12

- A display honouring Ian Bazalgette VC, the Alberta-born pilot to whom our Lancaster was dedicated in 1990, will be opened in Canada House on Trafalgar Square in London. Our museum has contributed to the development of the display. Museum director Dave Birrell will be travelling to London to represent the museum and speak at the official opening. He will likely mention the fact that we now have four engines operating on the "Ian Bazalgette Memorial Lancaster."
