
LANCASTER NIGHT RUN

RETURNING HANK'S MEDALS





Pilot Officer Henry Jackson DFC - 428 Squadron RCAF

Henry (Hank) Jackson was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for excellence and the completion of a full tour of 31 combat missions in Halifax bombers flying with the Murphy crew in RCAF 428 bomber squadron during 1943 - 1944.

Postwar, "Hank" lost his DFC and all his medals along with important RCAF papers. Now a retired Calgary policeman at age 95, and with the help of concerned family members and the efforts of the Bomber Command Museum of Canada, all of his priceless RCAF treasures have been found and will be returned to him at a special event on the "75th Anniversary of the Halifax Bomber" at the Bomber Command Museum of Canada on Saturday September 17th at 12:30 pm.
