- The most daring and tactically demanding air operation of World War II, the legendary Dambusters Raid utilized a bouncing bomb released at an altitude of sixty feet to destroy enemy hydroelectric dams. Only 11 of the 19 Lancasters returned. Of the 30 Canadians on the raid, 14 were killed.


